Navigating Bergen County's Most Dangerous Intersections

Bergen County's busy highways and local roads create numerous points where heavy traffic, merging vehicles, and frequent turns come together in some of the area's most dangerous intersections, including the following:

- **Routes 4 and 17, Paramus:** Major regional interchange connecting several highways and the George Washington Bridge, with exceptionally heavy rush-hour traffic documented by NJDOT.
- **Route 17 and Ridgewood Avenue, Paramus:** A dangerous combination of heavy retail and commuter traffic with frequent merging and lane changes.
- **Hackensack Avenue and Route 4, Hackensack:** Dense Route 4 lanes meet local commercial, university, and shopping traffic around the Hackensack River area.
- **Route 17 and Midland Avenue, Saddle Brook:** High-speed Route 17 traffic, access ramps, and local traffic all converge in a relatively compact area.
- **Route 4 and Forest Avenue, Paramus:** Busy crossing along the Route 4 retail sector, where congestion and turning traffic increase collision points.

Drivers should use extra caution at these intersections and interchanges, particularly during peak travel times. Slow down approaching intersections, leave extra following distance, avoid last-second lane changes, and watch carefully for pedestrians and turning vehicles.
